Honorary Member Marianne Tallberg by Diane Skiba & Kaija Saranto

It is with great sadness we share that Marianne Tallberg, PhD, RN, PHN died peacefully in Helsinki on 8 October 2023. She was one of the early IMIA NI members representing Finland and is one of our honorary members. Marianne became a nurse and returned to university to become a qualified nurse teacher with a BS in education, MA, and then PhD. Her PhD thesis examined the secular Finnish nurse from the 18th century to the beginning of uniform nursing education in 1930.



She started her academic career as a teacher at the Swedish School of Nursing in Helsinki. She then continued as Senior Lecturer at Helsinki University; Associate Professor in Nursing at the Universities of Tampere and Kuopio (now the University of Eastern Finland) and an Adjunct Professor at Kuopio University.

Marianne was an active member of the Finnish Nurses' Association including being appointed several times as Finland's representative at Nordic nursing congresses. Marianne Tallberg was a member of the Finnish Society of the History of Medicine, the International Society for the History of Medicine, the American Association for the History of Nursing and an honorary member of the

Finnish Social and Health Informatics Association. She also served on the editorial board of the Scandinavian Journal of Caring Sciences.

She was a member of IMIA NI from its inception and took the initiative to start the European Federation of Medical informatics Nursing Working Group (1988). In addition, she was a member of the European projects IT EDUCTRA and NIGHTINGALE, both of which were focused on nursing informatics. As the IMIA NI representative, she served on the Scientific Program Committee for the IMIA 5th International Conference in nursing use of computers and information sciences and was on the local organizing committee for the 6th IMIA International conference held in Stockholm, Sweden. Further, in 2009 she was on the Scientific Program Committee for the IMIA NI 9th International Conference held in Helsinki, Finland.

Marianne was a prolific author with numerous publications. Given her passion for nursing history, she is one of the three authors who wrote International Nursing Informatics: A History of the First Forty Years 1960-2000.

Among the many accolades she received, Marianne Tallberg was awarded the bronze Sophie Mannerheim Medal for her distinguished research on the founder of modern nursing education in Finland, and she was also awarded the Florence Nightingale Medal for her outstanding research in history and data technology in nursing.
