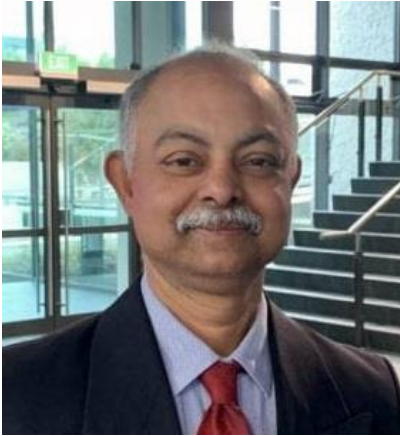


Inaugural Class of IAHSI – 2024
