Dr. Dorr earned his bachelor's degree in economics (with minors in mathematics and psychology) and his M.D. from Washington University in St. Louis. He then completed his internal medicine residency at Oregon Health & Science University and earned a master's degree in medical informatics and health services administration from the University of Utah. Dr. Dorr is the Chief Research Information Officer for OHSU as well as a Professor and Vice Chair in Medical Informatics & Clinical Epidemiology and a Professor of Medicine.

Broadly, Dr. Dorr's interests lie in complex care management, especially for older adults and other at-risk populations, coordination of care, collaborative care, chronic disease management, quality, and the requirements of clinical information systems to support these areas. From these interests, he has broadened into clinical information needs, Electronic Health Record (EHR) deployment and Health Information Exchange as a way to expand systems-based approaches to all of health care. Finally, Dr. Dorr performs evaluations of care management and informatics initiatives using a variety of methodologies.
