Her research area combines clinical research informatics with global health informatics. Her work on data standards, data sharing, data quality, and informatics-informed consortium management aims to simplify data harmonization and optimize collaboration within international observational research networks, with a focus on research resources that can adapt to partners in low- and middle-income countries. She co-teaches a Coursera online course on "Data Management for Clinical Research" that has reached over 75,000 learners worldwide. She also participates in the global consortium for the REDCap data collection software.
