Tso Ying Lee is Associate Professor of Nursing at the Taipei Medical University, Taiwan, and also employed at the TMU hospital, serving as the Director of the Nursing Research Center. She teaches nursing informatics at the graduate level and also supervises clinical internships for nursing informatics students. She conducts research on nursing clinical practice, with a special focus on nursing informatics and nursing administration.

Dr. Lee has been a nursing director and the CNIO in hospital, and has developed over a dozen systems, including scheduling systems, medication administration systems, materials management systems, patient safety reporting systems, and laboratory barcode scanning systems, among others, and won 6 information awards. From 2016 to 2021 she was the president of Taiwan Nursing Informatics Association, and also the member society (BCS) representative to IMIA-NI, acting as a liaison between the two organizations. From 2021 to 2024, served as the IMIA-NI vice chair.
