Anthony Maeder joined Flinders University in 2016 as Chair in Digital Health Systems and Co-Director of Flinders Digital Health Research Centre. His previous posts were at Western Sydney University (2008-16), where he founded the Telehealth Research and Innovation Laboratory (THRIL) and as Research Director of the CSIRO Australian eHealth Research Centre in Brisbane (2004-08).

He holds a PhD in Computing from Monash University awarded in 1992. He has a career record of >\$20M in research funding and ~400 peer reviewed papers. His main research expertise is in eHealth including telehealth, monitoring devices and web/mobile applications, and digital imaging including human factors and vision science.
