Mark Musen

Dr. Musen is a Professor at Stanford University. He conducts research related to open science and biomedical decision support. His group developed Protégé, the world's most widely used technology for building terminologies and ontologies. Dr. Musen directs the WHO Collaborating Center at Stanford University, which developed much of the information infrastructure for the authoring of ICD-11. He was the recipient of the Donald A. B. Lindberg Award for Innovation in Informatics from AMIA in 2006. He has been elected to the American College of Medical Informatics, the Association of American Physicians, and the U.S. National Academy of Medicine.
