### Vimla Patel

Vimla L Patel, PhD is a Senior Research Scientist and the Director of the Center for Cognitive Studies in Medicine and Public Health at the New York Academy of Medicine. She is Professor of Biomedical Informatics (BMI) at Arizona State University, and adjunct professor of BMI at Columbia University, and of Public Health at Weill Cornell College of Medicine. An elected fellow of the Royal Society of Canada (Academy of Social Sciences), the American College of Medical Informatics, and the New York Academy of Medicine, she is a recipient of a number of federal research grants from Canada and the USA over her career. A graduate of McGill University in Montreal, she received an Honorary Doctor of Science degree from the University of Victoria in Canada. She has served as a Vice President on the IMIA Board, and as a member of *Institute of Medicine* and the *National Research Council* committees related to social science, education and health Information technology research. She is an associate editor of the *Journal of Biomedical Informatics*. Dr. Patel's research focuses on medical decision making, cognitive informatics, medical errors, the impact of technology on human cognition, and resulting insights on designing an efficient and safer clinical workplace. She has published over 300 scholarly peer-reviewed articles and editor of seven books, spanning biomedical informatics, education, clinical, and cognitive science journals.
