Sharareh Rostam Niakan Kalhori holds a BSc in Public Health and an MSc in Health Services Management from Iran University of Medical Sciences, earned in 1999 and 2002 respectively. She furthered her education with a PhD in Informatics from the University of Manchester (UK) in 2011, followed by a Fellowship in Medical Informatics at the Peter Reichert Institute of Medical Informatics (PLRI), Technical University Braunschweig, and Hannover Medical School (Germany) in 2023. Sharareh was awarded scholarships from the Iranian Ministry of Health and Medical Education (MOHME) for her PhD and from the Alexander von Humboldt Foundation for her fellowship.

Beginning her academic career as a lecturer in 2012, Sharareh served as an Assistant Professor at Jundishapour University of Medical Sciences before transitioning to an Associate Professorship at Tehran University of Medical Sciences in 2015.
