Maxim (Max) Topaz

Dr. Topaz is an Elizabeth Standish Gill Associate Professor of Nursing and Data Science at Columbia University School of Nursing, New York, USA. Dr. Topaz has made notable contributions to health informatics over two decades. He developed Nimble Miner, an internationally used open-source NLP software for nursing data. His leadership has enhanced competency and fostered early career professionals. Dr. Topaz published over 120 peer-reviewed articles, supervised over twenty Ph.D. and postdoctoral students, and received numerous prestigious awards, including the Fulbright Award and American Medical Informatics Association New Investigator Award. Dr. Topaz co-founded and chaired IMIA's Student and Emerging Professionals Special Interest Group. Dr. Topaz is a Fellow of the American Academy of Nursing and serves as IMIA Board VP of IMIA's MEDINFO 2025. He serves as an associated editor or a member of editorial boards in leading health informatics journals (e.g., Journal of American Medical Informatics Association, International Journal of Medical Informatics).
