### Vivian Vimarlund

Vivian Vimarlund PhD., received a Bachelor degree of Science B.Sc. in Public Administration, Public Finance and Accounting from Linköping University, Sweden, 1994, a Masters in Economics from Linköping University, Sweden, 1995, and a PhD. in Informatics from Linköping University, Sweden, 1999.

She then began her academic career as a research scientist at the Department of Computer and Information Science at Linköping University, as Post doctor at the Department of Medical Informatics, University of Davis, California, and as Visiting Research at SRA, USA.

She has subsequently appointed as Assistant Professor of Informatics, and as Associate Professor in Economic Information Systems, at the Department of Computer and Information Science; Sweden. Dr. Vimarlund is currently a Professor in Informatics at the, Department of Computer and Information Science Linköping University, Sweden.

Professor Vivian Vimarlund has since 1994 conducted research within the area of Health Informatics with focus on Methods and Models to evaluate the impact of the implementation and use of eHealth innovations. The models and frameworks developed have a multidisciplinary character. They make it possible to provide insights into problems that have forced organizations to examine criteria for whether and when to invest resources, e.g., in eHealth services or in eHealth innovations.

Professor Vimarlund has a wide experience on management and leadership. Academic leadership has being practiced as: (i) Member of the mentorship programme, and Member of the International Affairs Committee at AMIA. (ii) Co-director of the master programme Software Engineering and Management at Linköping University, (iii) Dean of Research and Director of the Research Center (CENIT/IS) at the International Business School, Sweden, (iv) Scientific Secretary at SFMI, (v) Treasurer at The Swedish Artificial Intelligence Society, SAIS, (vi) Project leader for the project eHealth Research Network, Sweden (vii) Chair of the Working Group on Smart homes and Ambient Assisted Living.(IMIA) and as (viii) Gender Lecturer for the Technical School at Linköping University with the responsibility to renew and integrate gender issues in education and research.

Professor Vimarlund has received several awards for broadening the Field of Computer and Information Science.
