Dr. Ying (Helen) Wu is the Dean and Professor of School of Nursing and Clinical Nursing Courage, Capital Medical University in Beijing, China. She was honored as the “Beijing Municipality Renowned Teacher”, honorary Professor at the School of Nursing in Deakin University, Australia, and Honorary Alumni at the School of Nursing, University of Pittsburgh.

She is the current Vice President of International Medical Informatics Association, Past-President of Asia Pacific Association for Medical Informatics, Vice President of Chinese Medical Informatics Association, and Chair of the Professional Committee of Nursing Informatics (CMIA-NI). She also serves as the Board Member for International Council of Nurses and the Vice President of Chinese Nursing Association, and President (also founder) of the Association of Disaster and Emergency Nursing Rescue, Chinese Association of Medical Rescue.

She has more than 30 years of CVD experience in nursing practice (including advanced nursing practice), Education and research. Her research areas including CVD acute care and behavior changes for CVD patients, especially using mobile health technology. She is principal investigator of four projects funded by the Natural Science Foundation of China and more than 10 projects from other funding sources with a total funding of over 6 million (approximately over one million US\$). She has more than 140 publications and is the editor or vice editor for 15 books and author of more than 20 books. She is deputy editor or member on the editorial board of eight nursing professional journals.
