Paul G. Biondich, MD MS is Professor of Pediatrics and Informatics at Indiana University School of Medicine and the Director of Global Health Informatics at the Regenstrief Institute. His career focuses upon novel approaches to support the sustainable implementation of health information technology within resource-constrained settings. He is a founder and project lead of multiple international communities of practice, including Open Medical Record System (OpenMRS), Open Health Information Exchange (OpenHIE), and the Data Use Community (DUC). He is a fellow of the American College of Medical Informatics, and winner of both the Donald A.B. Lindberg Award and the Homer Warner Prize for innovations in medical informatics.
